Volunteer Position Summary:

As a Family Day Ambassador you will help increase access to the Taliesin Estate by serving as a resource for guests.

Tasks May Include:

- Greet guests and assist them to locate buildings, restrooms, parking, etc;
- Assist with the coordination of arriving and departing guests;
- Provide basic information about Frank Lloyd Wright, Taliesin, the Driftless region, and the logistics about Family Day;
- Provide information about Taliesin Preservation and its mission;
- Direct guests to the areas open for them to walk and visit; keep guests away from buildings or areas of the estate that are not open to the public;
- Communicate with the manager in charge of any issues or concerns;
- Assisting with set-up or take-down of event materials; and
- Other general assistance.

Time Commitment:

- Volunteers will be asked to complete a one-hour training session to get familiar with the Taliesin estate and the tasks:
- Family Day begins at 10:00 am and ends at 4:00 pm, but half-day shifts are available

Minimum Qualifications:

- Familiarity with Frank Lloyd Wright and Taliesin;
- Experience working in a customer service oriented role;
- Interest in working with people;
- Ability to take direction and work with minimal supervision; and
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills.
