Volunteer Position Summary:

The Google AdWords/Analytics Consultant works closely with the Communications Manager to drive website intelligence and improve Taliesin Preservation's online presence and drive area tourism and interest.

Tasks May Include:

- Use established communication goals to draft Google Ad Words campaigns to drive tourism and interest
- Utilize the nonprofit spending allowances from Google to implement creative campaigns based on seasonal themes
- Monitor website performance, trends, and campaigns using Google Analytics
- · Assist in web metrics reporting by creating and generating reports
- Support website and campaign optimization
- Proposing page updates, including meta keyword tags, header tags, and alt tags
- Assist with site map creation

Time Commitment:

- Volunteers will be asked to complete a one hour onboarding session with our Communications Manager (may be broken up)
- Due to the complexity of this role, volunteers are asked to commit for a six (6) month period
- 2-8 hours per week
- This work can be competed remotely
