Volunteer Position Summary:

The Preservation Assistant works with the Preservation Crew on specific restoration projects on the Taliesin estate in Wisconsin.

Tasks May Include:

- Skilled work to preserve, stabilize and restore the buildings that comprise the Taliesin estate including carpentry, masonry, concrete, structural reinforcement, restoration, stabilization, plasterwork, painting, staining, etc.;
- Assists in documenting preservation work as it is planned and occurs; and
- General building maintenance to keep the spaces presentable for the tour program.

Time Commitment:

- Volunteers will be required to complete relevant OSHA safety training prior to commencing any work;
- Time commitment will vary depending on project and volunteer availability but volunteers will be asked to commit for the full duration of the project; and
- The preservation crew works on the estate Monday through Friday. Volunteer shifts are available on those days.

Minimum Qualifications:

- Volunteers must already possess the skills necessary for the project they commit to. Generally this will be considered 3-5 years of work related experience. In some specialized cases, more experience may be necessary. If your skills come from a hobby, providing a portfolio of your work is required;
- Possession of work tools is a plus;
- Thorough working knowledge of construction standards, methods, and materials; and
- Ability to take direction and work independently.
